

The Invest in Kids Act provides for the creation of scholarships that are of equal or lesser value to the statewide average operational expense provided for in public schools. Uniquely, the law also establishes three scholarship multipliers that add to the overall scholarship value. In order to qualify for each of these multipliers, a student must meet the qualification criteria, and provide the necessary paperwork as proof of qualification. The below outlines these requirements:

Name of Multiplier	Multiplier Amount	Qualifying
Unique Learners	2x	Students who qualify for services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) are qualified to receive the multiplier. In order to confirm this status, families must submit proof of a valid Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or Individualized Services Plan (ISP).
English Language Learners	1.2x	Students in pre-K-12 who were born in the United States of parents possessing no or limited English-speaking ability and who are incapable of performing ordinary classwork in English. In order to confirm this status, families must note this in the student application process.
Gifted and Talented Learners	1.1x	Students will be considered gifted and talented in any area of aptitude, and, specifically in language arts and mathematics, by scoring in the top 5% locally in that area of aptitude. In order to confirm this status, families must note this in the student application process.
